Red Mountain Invitational Team Invitation



Hello, Coaches!

AYSO Region 1079 is proud to invite your team to Red Mountain Invitational

Scope: AYSO Open Invitational – open to AYSO teams and Non AYSO teams.

When: Friday, Saturday & Sunday, April 9-11, 2010

Where: The tournament will be held at Red Mountain and Quail Run Soccer complexes. If additional fields are need we will use Red Mtn. High School. No pets are allowed at fields.

Who: AYSO 2009 primary season- boys and girls teams in age divisions: U-19, U-16 (11v11) 18 players max. U-14 (11v11) 15 players max. U-12 (9v9) 12 players max. and U-10 (7v7) 10 players max. All players must have been registered, and have played, in the AYSO 2009 primary season. Guest players will be allowed (3 maximum per team). Co-ed teams will be accepted in boys' divisions only.

What: Pool play tournament. Each team will be guaranteed 3 games in pool play. The top teams will advance to the medal round on Sunday afternoon. Any division with an odd number of teams will play 4 games and tournament placement will be determined by total points. All games will be as follows: (80 min. for U-19 & U-16, 70 min. for U-14, 60 min for U-12, and 50 min for U-10).

Why: RMI is being conducted as a fundraiser by Region 1079 to raise funds for field development and help support secondary teams.

Awards: All players and 2 coaches per team will receive a tournament t-shirt and pin. All players on the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th place teams will receive a medal. One team in each division will be given sportsmanship award.

Entry Fee, Refunds: \$400 for U-19 & U-16, \$375 for U-14 & U-12, and \$350 for U-10. A full refund will be issued if tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled. If a team withdraws 30 or more days before the tournament, a full refund is given. Within 30 days of the tournament, no refund is provided unless a replacement team is found.

Referee Fee, Refunds: \$150, refundable within 14 days of the tournament, if referee assignments have been completed. Each team is asked to provide a qualified 3-person referee team to cover 3 games during the tournament. Partial refunds will be given based upon the number of game slots completed.

Rules: A full set of tournament rules are posted on the tournament website.

Acceptance: The application deadline is March 8, 2010. All teams will be notified within 48 hrs. of the application deadline or receipt of application (whichever is latest) as to their status. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their money returned or to be placed on the waiting list.

How: Team entry applications and all necessary forms are available on the tournament website. Please send 1 Region/Club check that covers both the Entry and Referee fees, along with the tournament application, referee information form, and team roster to the Tournament Registrar address below. Regional commissioner/Club registrar must sign application and team roster. Checks must be made out to AYSO 1079 and must arrive no later than March 8, 2010. No verbal reservations will be accepted. AYSO/Club teams must submit checks drawn on a regional NAP/Club account.
